Personal Information and Information Sharing

For each visit to our login page www.openautodrive.org we automatically recognize your IP address, domain and web browser. This information is not used to personally identify you. We use your IP address to help diagnose possible problems with our server farm and Internet connection. We do not sell or market this information to any third party.

During the registration/sign-up processes, you provide us with personally identifiable information such as name, email address and company. This information is used primarily to identify you in our service, which is necessary for the login process. The individual user account is based on e-mail addresses. We do not share this information with anyone, nor do we sell or market this information to any third party.
